Foundation Degree in Dance and Theatre Arts (DATA)

Course overview

This course is aimed at students who have completed Level 3 qualifications and who want to consider a career in performance or dance. The core units designed for the two pathways of dance and theatre arts will introduce Contextual Studies, Introduction to Specialist Pathway and Understanding the Industry which will provide the key knowledge to set up the artist within the industry as a teacher, performer, arts development officer or community arts worker.

Entry requirements

National Diploma in Performing Arts or Dance or two A levels.

Course length and mode of attendance

2 years, full time study. Attendance is two and a half days a week

What will I study?

Modules will include:

- Professional Practice
- Professional and Contextual Studies 1 and 2
- Understanding the Industry
- Investigation Expression and Reflection
- Introduction to Specialist Pathway
- Creativity & Social Context

What qualification will I obtain?

Foundation Degree in Dance and Theatre Arts (DATA).

How will I be assessed?

There will be a combination of both practical and written assignments developing performance and presentation skills, essay and report writing and project based management. All assessment is course work based and is assessed throughout the year.

Where will it lead?

Students can top up the foundation degree to a full degree at University or can go into the Industry within their chosen field.
