Foundation Degree in the Creative and Cultural Industries: Digital Media Production - Moving Image, New Media, Photography

Course overview

The Foundation Degree in Digital Media Production has three pathways. Students are able to select one of the pathways to follow, these are Film Production, Multimedia or Photography. Alongside the specialist units for each pathway you will study generic units covering Media: Institution, History and Context.

Entry requirements

160 UCAS points or relevant experience.

Course length and mode of attendance

The course is full or part time. Full time study is two and a half days per week for two years.

What will I study?

Your Foundation Degree will be made up of thirteen units which will be a combination of specialist and generic units.

What qualification will I obtain?

Foundation Degree in Digital Media Production from Staffordshire University/Burton College.

How will I be assessed?

Continuous assessment both practical and written.

Where will it lead?

From the course you can go on to do the final year in a BA (Hons) Degree in Media, Multimedia, Photography or a related degree. The qualification is also designed to enable you to go straight into employment in the Media Industry
