Foundation Degree in Construction (Architectural Design)

Course overview

This Foundation Degree is designed for people who are employed in the construction industry in the field of Architectural Design. However, other people employed in the fields of Building Surveying and Construction Management will benefit from the course. It is validated through Staffordshire University.

Entry requirements

The entry requirements are A Level, AVCE, BTEC National qualifications and GCSE Maths and English at grades C or above. For mature students a significant portfolio of relevant work experience.

Course length and mode of attendance

This is a three year part-time course. You will need to attend College one day a week with the possibility of one evening attendance.

What will I study?

Year 1 - Six units including:

- Learning Skills in Construction.
- The Development Process.
- Design and Procedures.

Year 2 - Six units including:

- Construction Science and Materials.
- Health, Safety and Welfare.
- Contractual Procedures.

Year 3 - Six units including:

- Individual Project.

What qualification will I obtain?

You will obtain a Foundation Degree in Construction (Architectural Design).

How will I be assessed?

The course will be assessed through examinations, assignments and presentations.

Where will it lead?

Successful completion of the Foundation Degree in construction provides a platform to complete a BSc (Hons) in Construction. It will also provide entry to certain professional bodies.
