Course overview

This qualification is intended who wish to obtain higher technician status within the Construction Industry.

Entry requirements

The entry requirements are A Level, AVCE, BTEC National qualifications and GCSE Maths and English at grades C or above. For mature students a significant portfolio of relevant work experience.

Course length and mode of attendance

This is a two year part time course. You will need to attend College on a part time day and evening basis. Year one is on a Tuesday, year two on a Wednesday.

Students may start in either September or February.

What will I study?

Design Principles and Application.

Analytical Methods.

Technology A.

Health, Safety and Welfare.

Management Principles and Application.

Year 2 -

Group Project.

Technology B.

Science and Materials.

Production Management.

Site Surveying Procedures.

What qualification will I obtain?

You will obtain a BTEC Higher National Certificate in Construction.

How will I be assessed?

The course will be assessed through examinations, assignments and presentations.

Where will it lead?

Successful completion can lead to an HND simply by adding six more units to the certificate. Alternatively, we currently have arrangements with The Nottingham Trent University that allows students to automatically progress to an appropriate degree programme. the HNC will open up opportunities to work in a variety of construction disciplines.
