# Higher National Diploma in Construction

## Course overview

This qualification is intended for those wishing to obtain higher technician status within the construction Industry.

## Entry requirements

The entry requirements are A Level, BTEC National qualifications and GCSE Maths and English at grades C or above. For mature students a significant portfolio of relevant work experience.

## Course length and mode of attendance

This is a two year part course. You will need to attend College on a part time day and evening basis. Year one is on a Tuesday, year two is on a Wednesday. Students may start in September or February.
