# HND/ Foundation Degree in Music/Media Technology

### Course overview

This qualification aims to give students the opportunity to develop the skills involved in the creation and management and use of technology involved in the Music and Media Industry.

### Entry requirements

160 UCAS points or relevant experience subject to a formal interview.

### Course length and mode of attendance

Full time, two and half days per week.

### What will I study?

Year 1 and 2 modules include:

Audio Processing

Music Business

Multimedia Applications

Recording Studio Techniques

Music Technology Project

Internet and Communications Skills

Professions Work-Based Experience

- Independent study is encouraged throughout the course and a professional working environment and industry standard technology resources are available to students.

### What qualification will I obtain?

Higher National Diploma or Foundation Degree in Music/Media Technology.

### How will I be assessed?

Year One, Semester One - 6 practical assignments.

Year One, Semester Two - 2 practical assignments.

Year Two - 6 practical assignments including a major project.

### Where will it lead?

Upon successful completion, students will be able to study for a BA (Hons) in Music/ Media Technology (Top up) Degree.

Students will be qualified to work within the music media related industries providing technical expertise for sound production and quality in recording studios, live sound venues and digital videos.
