HND Sports Performance and Coaching

Course overview

This specially designed HND in Sports Performance and Coaching aims to equip students with the knowledge and practical skills they need to achieve success in the expanding sport, leisure, health and fitness industries, or to progress to an undergraduate degree programme.

Entry requirements

An advanced GNVQ or AVCE or

A BTEC National Certificate or Diploma or

1 A Level pass

Students should also have three GCSEs including English and Maths at grade C or above. Mature students who have appropriate work experience will be considered.

Course length and mode of attendance

Full time 2 year Diploma.

What will I study?

This vocationally orientated programme offers a wide range of specialised modules including Optimising Sporting Performance, Physical and Psychological Scientific Principles, Promoting a Healthy Lifestyle, Outdoor and Adventure Activities, and Sports Development.

What qualification will I obtain?

HND Sports Performance and Coaching (16 modules).

How will I be assessed?

Due to the vocational nature of the industry the course aims at promoting practical coursework and assessments.

Assessments use a combination of assignments, group project work and exams.

Assessments are designed to be industry related and integrate key transferable skills such as problem solving, analysis and communication skills.

Where will it lead?

The HND is an excellent route for those aspiring to become a Physical Education Teacher or a Teacher in Further Education. Many other careers are catered for including Sports Development Officer, Physiotherapist, Sports Scientist, Sports Coach, Outward Bound Instructor, Sports Researcher, Health and Fitness Consultant.
