Certificate in Education / PGCE: Post Compulsory Education (In Service)

Course overview

The Cert Ed/PGCE: Post Compulsory Education is intended for full-time and part-time teachers in Further, Tertiary, Higher, Adult, Health Services or Prison Education, or any related field of post compulsory education or training. This in-service teacher training course and the final qualification, awarded by the Nottingham Trent University, is restricted to those who teach in the post compulsory sector of education and training. The course does not lead automatically to qualified teacher status within the compulsory education sector.

Entry requirements

1. Academically qualified in the subject you wish to teach.
2. Access to a minimum number of 100 hours of paid teaching during each of the two years.
3. Level 2 qualifications in literacy and Numeracy.

Course length and mode of attendance

34 weeks, half-day.

What will I study?

Professional Context PCE.
Preparing and Planning.
Management of Learning Assessment.
Diagnosis of Learners Needs.
Reflective Practice.

What qualification will I obtain?

Professional Graduate Certificate in Education: Lifelong Learning Sector. Certificate in Education: Lifelong Learning Sector.

How will I be assessed?

A process of continuous assessment is used throughout the course. Course members must complete all elements of the assessed work to the standard set out in the regulations and requirements of the Nottingham Trent University Examination Board.
